Hints and Tips

We have had some great feedback from members regarding the 'Household Tips' section in our last newsletter. We think the most used one was putting ice cubes in your hanging baskets, genius idea! Here are a few more for you to try

- Before hanging a picture on the wall, put some toothpaste on the back of it. Press the picture where you want to hang it so the toothpaste transfers to the wall. You now have a mark so you know exactly where to bang in the nail!

Delicious Cupcakes!

Feeling Christmassy?

Why not have a go at making some decorations out of felt?

For this tree, cut out 2 triangles with pinking shears and use a straight stitch round the edges inserting a small length of ribbon at the top for a loop and a piece of brown felt at the bottom.

Before completely sewing up the tree, push in a small amount of wadding to pad out. Sew on tiny buttons for baubles. Please be aware that because of small parts, this is not a toy.
