Time banking

Time Bank Uttlesford is a community initiative that brings together those in our community who need assistance with those who are able and willing to offer such help.

It is volunteering with a difference: volunteers are rewarded with time credits for the hours they spend helping someone else. One hour spent volunteering is equal to one time credit. Members can spend their time credits on help or support they need or donate them to others. Everyone's time is equal no matter what each hour is spent doing.

It is free to join and open to anyone over the age of 18, regardless of ability, skills or situation. It is also available to groups and organisations.

We currently have 88 individual members, 6 Organisation members and 5 mini time banks (being groups of 5 or more volunteers) who have collectively generated 1913 voluntary hours to date.
